**UVB** light FOREST 5%\* LAMP T5HO 8-12 hours a day Sign of Forest 5% Lamp 5-12% according to cage height (for Ca and D3 metabolism) Full spectrum or natural light 12 hours per day Visible light (to see) Low 80s °F (26-28°C) IR light (to bask) 1 hour max 2 times a day Temperature at daytime Mid 70s °F (21-23°C) Max Low 60s °F (15-17°C) Temperature at night Ideally 50s °F, below 15°C **Humidity at daytime** 50-70% **Humidity at night** 100%, Fog Fogger at night **Hydration** Hand misting, Dripper Crickets, Soldier Flies, Roaches Food type No vegetables, No fruits Juveniles no limit Food volume Adults max 1 cricket daily **Supplementation Plain Calcium** - each meal **Bee Pollen** Calcium with D3 Supplementation - once in two weeks Multivitamin Clean up poop and food remnants Cleaning Sanitize hands
